ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. U. S. Citizen or eligible noncitizen*
2. Be a graduating high school senior who is a Lake or Geauga County resident
3. Be an African American, American Indian, Asian Pacific American, or Hispanic American
4. Minimum grade point average of 2.75 (on a 4.0 scale), 2.5 maintained in college
5. Must be accepted to attend full-time at a four-year accredited college/university to study in one of the following fields:

Chemical engineering	Computer science	Finance
Mechanical engineering	Information systems management	Communication
Chemistry	Business	
Polymer science	Accounting	

In the event the student does not stay enrolled in one of these areas, future awards will be forfeited.

6. Must not be a dependent of a Lubrizol employee


SELECTION CRITERIA: The selection committee is seeking to award to high achieving students who demonstrate dedication to completing a bachelor's degree education. Qualified candidates will be judged on the following:

1. Academic achievement
2. Financial need
3. Determination to obtain an undergraduate degree in one of the required fields
4. Evidence of involvement in community and school based activities and service
5. Leadership roles
6. Letter of recommendation

DOCUMENTATION

1. Lubrizol Corporation Minority Scholarship Application completed and signed. All questions must be answered. Additional sheets may be added if the space provided is insufficient. No other documents will be considered.
2. One letter of recommendation, from a counselor or teacher who has first hand knowledge of your accomplishments and goals in the subject area you plan to study.
3. Copy of your high school transcript, showing current grade point average, SAT/ACT scores
4. Copy of your Student Aid Report, ALL PAGES, from filing the FAFSA
5. Copy of the official award letter from the college you plan to attend

DEADLINE: The application and all documents must be received in our office not later than May 4, 2012. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

8. Future scholarship awards will be forfeited if the student changes their major to a field not listed in the scholarship criteria.
